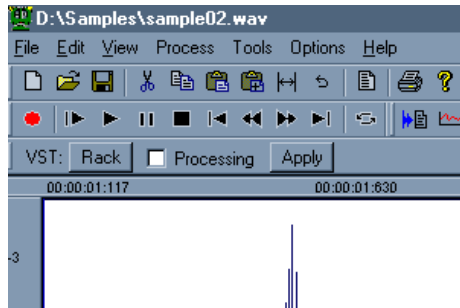
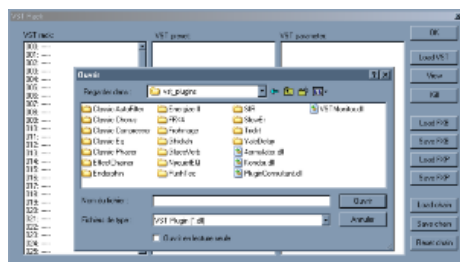


How to use VST plugin effects with Wavosaur



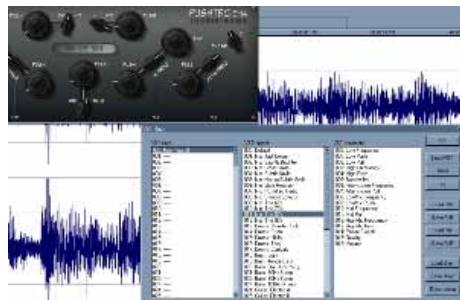
1.

Open the VST Rack by clicking on the "Rack" Button located under the transport bar.



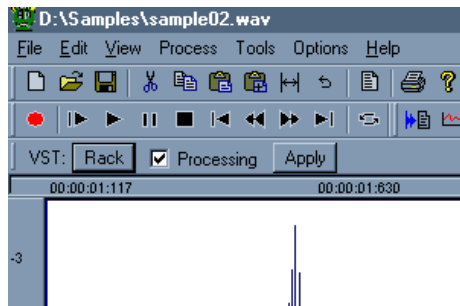
2.

Select "Load VST" and choose your plugin DLL in the dialog box.



3.

Click on "View" to open the VST effect GUI. You can browse through the preset list (the second tab).



4.

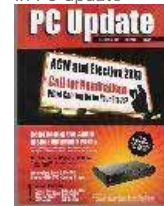
Check "Processing": now the played audio is processed in real time by the VST. You can tweak the VST parameters and hear the changes in real time.

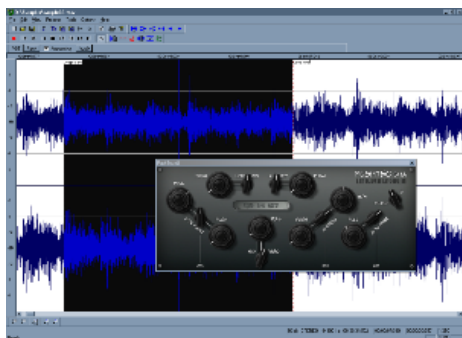
